What is Alpha Sigma Nu?

Selection to Alpha Sigma Nu is one of the highest honors on a Jesuit campus. Alpha Sigma Nu is the honor society of Jesuit institutions of higher education. The society was founded in 1915 to honor a select number of students each year on scholarship, loyalty, and service. Alpha Sigma Nu is unique among honor societies in that it seeks to identify the most promising students in Jesuit schools. Candidates must rank in the top 15 percent of their class and must be of at least junior status. Inductees demonstrate an intelligent appreciation of and commitment to the ideals —intellectual, social, moral, and religious—of Jesuit higher education.

Choice. Control. Character.

During the month of March, events and traditions associated with spring break, St. Patrick's Day, and the NCAA's 'March Madness' take socializing to another level, a level that often involves risky drinking behavior. To help your son or daughter to make safe and responsible decisions, ask them about their social plans and talk specifically about drinking.

Here are a few tips that may be helpful:

The best way to avoid dangerous situations is not to drink. The only legal option for students under the age of 21 is to not drink.



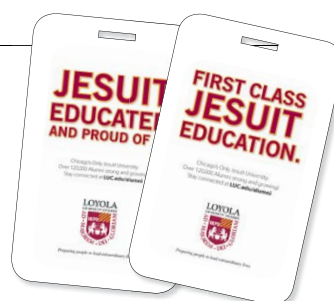
For students who choose to drink, these tips can help to keep them safer:

- Set a limit.
- Pace drinks to one or fewer per hour.
- Have a plan for how to turn down (or delay) a drink.
- Steer clear of drinking games.
- Have a non-alcoholic beverage, like water, between drinks.
- Make a pact with friends that no one goes to or from a party alone.
- Don't drink and drive. Carry extra money for cab fare.
- Don't accept open container beverages from anyone but a bartender.
- Get a new beverage if you've left yours unattended or if you're not sure it's yours.

Call of the Open Road

Los Angeles, CA and Washington DC

February 28–March 5

The OnCall program has officially switched gears for the spring: while the fall semester challenged students to explore their different desires in the light of Ignatian Spirituality, this semester we'll be hitting the road and putting our reflection into action. Inspired by the PBS series Road Trip Nation, two groups of eight Loyola students will be traveling to Washington D.C. and Los Angeles to interview people who are living extraordinary lives about their career paths and how they found their purpose and calling in life.

igNation EVOKEation

igNation EVOKEation is based on EVOKE's very successful "Call of the Open Road" program. For students who are not able to take part in the spring break immersion, this "indie" experience allows students to explore their callings throughout the academic year with the support of EVOKE. Over a period of a few weeks, students build a team of 2-4 participants, work with EVOKE, and set up conversations with 1-2 inspiring people in Chicago. Pilgrimage to Lourdes, France

May 11–21

This 10-day service immersion trip to Lourdes, France is being offered in collaboration with the School of Nursing, Evoke, and University Ministry. A total of 11 students (2 seniors, 9 juniors) were accepted to participate in this pilot immersion trip. Nursing faculty member, P. Ann Solari-Twadell, Executive Director of Evoke, Dawn Overstreet, and Director of University Ministry, Chris Murphy will be leading the trip in conjunction with Our Lady of Lourdes Hospitality, North American Volunteers.

The immersion is both a pilgrimage and service trip. The students will be actively engaged in service each day. Service sites include: helping the sick and suffering in the baths, assisting pilgrims off the trains, cleaning the care facility, attending to wounded American soldiers at the care facility, and assisting with the evening vigils/processions.

Some of the highlights from the week include: collaborations with Aramark and CUERP on the brand new "trayless" week and Hunger Week meals in the dining halls, as well as with Gannon Center on the Sustainable Dinner which highlighted a growing trend on sustainable living. Other notable events were the 5K Walk/Run which increased tremendously in participation. This year over 160 people came out to support the event. The week was packed with a large variety of events sponsored by many different organizations on campus. The Online Silent Auction was a tremendous success!

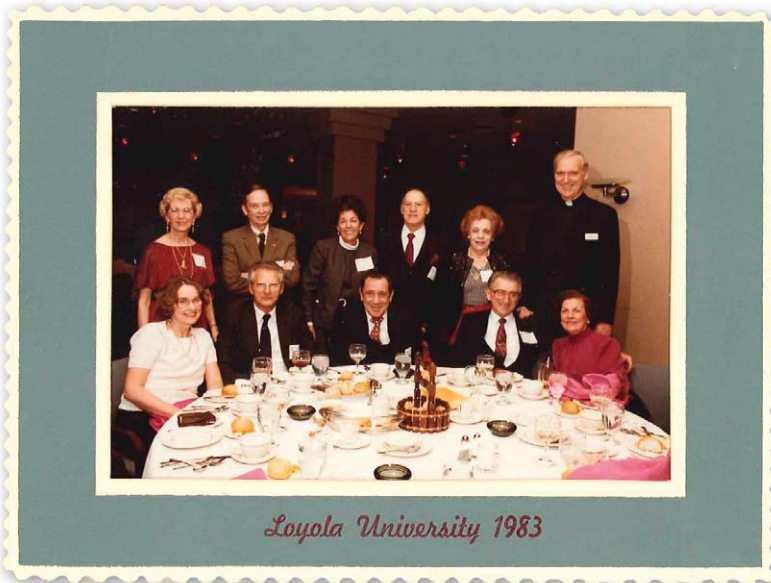

Rocco Pacelli, beloved husband of the late Grace (nee Sacco) and loving father of four children Anthony, Danita, Richard (BS '76, DDS '82) and Marianne truly believed in the importance of higher education, especially a Loyola degree. Rocco, a highly decorated Captain in the U.S. Army WWII, completed a high school education, but always taught his children the importance of continuing education, especially college and advanced college degrees.

Both Rocco and his wife Grace became involved in Loyola University Chicago Parents' Association in the early 1980s when their son, Richard attended Loyola. "Since neither of them attended college they always wanted their children to have a college education. They truly embodied Loyola's mission and became involved in the Loyola Parents' Association being wonderful ambassadors for many years."

They also became very active in fundraising for the School of Nursing to raise additional support from parents to provide financial assistance to Loyola nursing students.

Fr. John Reilly, S.J., who worked on the parents program during that time, remembers both Rocco and Grace's involvement as parents. "They were good workers for the Parents Associates programs and charming, always with a smile," said Fr. Reilly.

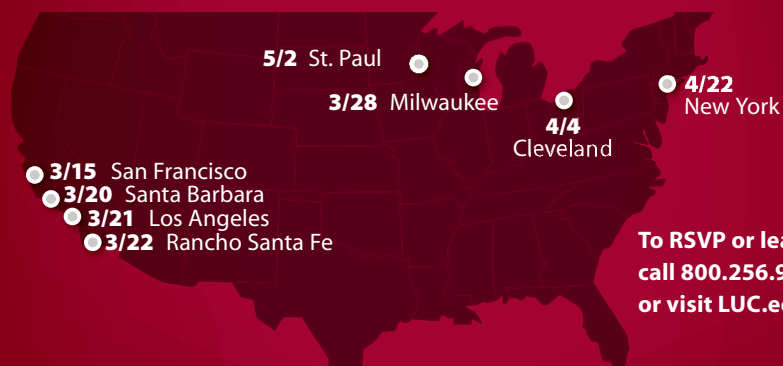
